


## Deck Surfacing Detail



## **Substrate Requirements**

- 1. A minimum of  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch T&G plywood must be used and should be glued and screwed in place. Install with adequate slope to insure proper drainage.
- 2. Make sure that the surface is clean and free of oil, paint, tar or other potential bond breakers.
- 3. The StoneCraft urethane membrane will cover the entire deck surface as well as 6 inches up the exterior walls and under any exterior doorframes. Make sure that doors are removed and tar paper is lifted 12 inches to provide access for this detail.
- 4. The plywood surface should extend tightly to the perimeter walls and outer edge.
- 5. If required, surface drains must be installed flush with the surface of the plywood.
- 6. Railing may be surface mounted after the SoneCraft system is complete. Pre-drill anchor holes and then fill with silicone or urethane caulking before threading in fasteners. The fastener will displace some of the sealant out of the hole insuring a good seal from the inside out.
- All flashings are to be installed by StoneCraft.
